FESTIVAL VISION: Our vision & purpose is to showcase Oklahoma (hopefully out of state teams in the future) HS & MS cross country at the very start of the season. We are honored to have you all (our state's best xc schools) attend every year. FESTIVAL LOCATION: Deer Creek High School, 6101 NW 206th St, Edmond, OK 73012. The course starts & finishes north & west of our high school & intermediate school, follows the perimeter of our practice athletic fields, and is flat & spectator friendly. Buses should park in the Performing Arts & Athletic Center (PAAC) parking lot adjacent to MacArthur Blvd.

REGISTRATION & CHIP TIMING: All entries will be done on-line at: ok.milesplit.com and all timing and results will be **CHIP TIMED** this year through twelverunning.com . - - - **ENTRY DEADLINE: Thursday @ 12 Noon (8/22/2024)** for HS registration and **Tuesday @ 12 Noon (8/20/2023)** for MS registration.

Teams and students must be entered/registered before the deadline by setting up your roster at milesplit.com and entering the Field Run Festival. Teams will not be added at the meet. Each Team will receive a packet with bibs for each runner. The bib has an RFID chip in it and must be worn on the front (chest area). Students (or coaches) will not be allowed in the finish area with their bibs with them. AWARDS: Top 30 individuals receive medals (**CUSTOM MEDALS by ENDURO**) in each division. We will score each division.

ENTRY FEES:

- \$125.00 for all 3 HS divisions/races per gender, so \$250 max for both boys and girls. We are providing more racing & medaling opportunities with our 3 levels of competition in our 6 races than you will find anywhere else, and these medals are Enduro custom medals in each of those divisions, as well as chip timing. Please contact me if you have any questions.
- \$65 for each middle school division, or \$250 max for all four divisions: 8th girls, 8th boys, 7th girls, 7th boys.

SPECTATORS POLICIES/ ADMISSION:

- There will be an admission gate for spectators, following our district's recommendations (likely \$5).
- Spectators are defined as anyone not competing, coaching, or volunteering in the event. We understand that camaraderie and support of one's teammates is a vital component of cross country.
- The starting line area, the finish line area, and the chute will be strictly limited to athletes and coaches--no spectators.

TEAM CAMP ASSIGNMENTS:

- Teams will have 2 designated areas for team camp, in order to stay off the course and avoid congestion there.
- Team Camp Area 1: Intermediate School Softball Field
- Team Camp Area 2: Intermediate School Baseball Field
